Keyhole Reservoir Carp Bowfishing Tournament Rules and Regulations

1. Tournament headquarters will be at the Keyhole Marina.
2. Each Entrant is required to wear a PFD upon take-off each day. Safety at take-off will be everyone's responsibility.
3. Boats will receive an inspection prior to departure. No boat may contain Carp or alcoholic beverages on board prior to take-off.
4. Registration begins Saturday morning at 6:30 AM followed by a short rules meeting. Boat launch will begin at 8 AM. Tournament will end at 4 PM.
5. All teams are required to sign a waiver.
6. Winning positions will be determined by the total number of fish harvested. Ties will be broken by measuring the length of the largest fish followed by the length of the shortest if needed.
7. Use of bows and crossbows only, no multiple fishing points allowed.
8. All arrows must have a line attached to them and the line attached to the bow.
9. No nets allowed
10. No transferring fish from one team to another.
11. This tournament is for shooting carp only, as shooting a gamefish is illegal.
12. Any team arriving late at checkpoint will be disqualified.
13. Eligibility: Each team must have one member of at least 18 years of age or parental consent.
14. Release of Liability: By signing the tournament entry form, all participants agree to the following Release of Liability: We, in consideration being permitted to participate in NEWWA Carp Tourney, our heirs, executors, administrators and assigns hereby release and forever discharge NEWWA from any and every claim, demand known or unknown, death or property damage resulting or to result from any accident which may occur as a result of our participation in the NEWWA Carp Tourney whether by negligence or otherwise.
15. All contestants must observe U.S. Coast Guard and Wyoming Parks & Historic Sites rules and regulations. Boats must have an attached Coast Guard rating plate. The motors horsepower may not exceed the rating. Contestants must comply with all Wyoming Game & Fish regulations.
